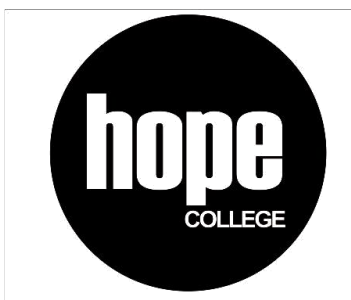

### **ENTRY CRITERIA FOR**

#### **10745NAT Graduate Certificate in Christian Ministry and Theology**

Applicants must be actively involved in a leadership role within a Christian church and have completed a 10745NAT Advanced Diploma of Christian Ministry and Theology or equivalent, or recognised Australian undergraduate degree or higher, or equivalent overseas qualification.

#### **10746NAT Graduate Diploma in Christian Ministry and Theology**

Applicants must be actively involved in a leadership role within a Christian church and have completed a 10745NAT Advanced Diploma of Christian Ministry and Theology or equivalent, or recognised Australian undergraduate degree or higher, or equivalent overseas qualification.

### **WORK BASED TRAINING**

#### **10745NAT Graduate Certificate in Christian Ministry and Theology**

In addition to study time students are required to complete 120 hours of volunteer work within their local church. This volunteer work is called "Work-Based Training". 10745NAT Graduate Certificate in Christian Ministry and Theology students are expected to minister in a leadership role within their local church, where they are required to develop others.

#### **10746NAT Graduate Diploma of Christian Ministry and Theology**

In addition to study time students are required to complete 240 hours of volunteer work within their local church. This volunteer work is called "Work-Based Training". 10746NAT Graduate Diploma of Christian Ministry and Theology students are expected to minister in a leadership role within their local church, where they are required to develop others.

### **RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING**

Recognition of prior learning (RPL) is a process where students may be granted credit towards a qualification in recognition of their prior skills and knowledge gained through work experience, life experience and/or formal training. The process requires students to gather evidence of their skills. Fees apply. Ask Hope College for an RPL application form.

### **RTO'S OBLIGATION TO RECOGNISE – Direct Credit Transfer (DCT)**

Hope College recognises and accepts Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) qualifications and Statements of Attainment issued by any other Registered Training Organisation (RTO). Direct Credit Transfer (DCT) will be given to any student who has successfully completed units in any of our accredited courses with another RTO. Students must produce a certified copy of their Record of Results/Statement of Attainment for our records prior to the commencement of studies. There is no fee for DCT.

### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

All applicants must:

- Complete a Student Application Form
- Provide a USI number
- Pay \$150 non-refundable application fee (per course)
- Read the Student Handbook and sign the Student Handbook Declaration Slip
- Obtain a reference from your local church pastor (Pastoral Reference Form available From Hope College website)
- Write a short essay giving your reasons for studying this course
- Complete Work-Based Training Agreement and Plan

### **ASSESSMENT**

Assessment tasks include: questions, case scenarios, research, portfolios and workplace competency. Upon successful completion of the course requirements you will be awarded a 10745NAT Graduate Certificate in Christian Ministry and Theology or a 10746NAT Graduate Diploma of Christian Ministry and Theology. Participants who exit the course without completing all requirements will be issued with a Statement of Attainment for those units in which they have demonstrated competency.

### **COURSE FEES**

#### **10745NAT Graduate Certificate in Christian Ministry and Theology**

Course fees total \$2,350, which includes a \$150 non-refundable application fee. The course is paid in 2 instalments.

Each instalment of \$1,100 is made in full at the start of each term.

#### **10746NAT Graduate Diploma of Christian Ministry and Theology**

Course fees total \$4,550, which includes a \$150 non-refundable application fee. The course is paid in 4 instalments.

Each instalment of \$1,100 is made in full at the start of each term.

### ***WORK LOAD:***

#### ***Six months Full-time - 10745NAT Graduate Certificate in Christian Ministry and Theology***

6 subjects plus 120 hours Work-based Training over the duration of 6 months. This is broken down into 60 hours of WBT each term. There are 3 subjects for each term.

#### ***One year Full-time - 10746NAT Graduate Diploma of Christian Ministry and Theology***

8 subjects plus 240 hours Work-based Training over the duration of 1 year. This is broken down into 60 hours of WBT each term. There are 2 subjects for each term.

Please note: the availability of the class is subject to minimum class size.
